

Journal entries

Every two weeks, you must submit a math journal entry of at least two pages. This journal entry should be a reflection on the mathematics that you have learned or explored in this class in the past two weeks.

This is meant to give you an opportunity to talk about mathematics out loud, but with yourself. You are allowed to write something, and then question, “wait, what do I mean by that?” You are allowed to claim something, and then question, “wait, is that true?”

You will not be graded on mathematical correctness, but you will be graded on integrity (are you being honest about your knowledge versus your beliefs versus what you have simply heard?) and scientific thought (are you exploring and demonstrating appropriate levels of inquiry and introspection?).

As with all assignments, your submission will be shared with the class from time to time, so do not include your name if you want to keep your name private.
